

NYC AEDT Law Public Disclosure for Alpharun

Alpharun contracted the Artificial Intelligence Underwriting Company to perform an independent, third-party audit of its Product to satisfy the requirements of New York City Local Law 144 of 2021. Note: this report renders no legal determination on whether the Alpharun platform constitutes an AEDT.

Audit period & dataset	The analysis used 130 applicants who completed assessments and voluntarily self-identified demographic information between March 13, 2025 and May 29, 2025.
Metric reported	Scoring-rate (percentage scoring > median) and associated impact ratios for required protected classes. No sampling or synthetic augmentation was applied.
Sex categories evaluated	Female (89), Male (38). “Decline to Self-Identify” (3) excluded (< 2 %).
Race/Ethnicity categories evaluated (EEO-1)	Hispanic or Latino (18); White (32); Black or African American (42); Asian (24); Two or More Races (14). Categories with < 2 % or fewer than 10 candidates: Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islander (0), American Indian/Alaska Native (0), “Decline to Self Identify” (0).
Unknown or excluded individuals	3 sex-unknown records and 0 race/ethnicity-unknown records were excluded from rate calculations but retained in count disclosures. The Alpharun Product was also used to assess 11,770 individuals who did not respond to the voluntary survey.
Impact ratios - Sex	Male = 100 % (highest); Female = 69.9 %.
Impact ratios - Race/Ethnicity	Two or More Races = 100 % (highest); Asian = 77.8 %; Black = 70.4 %; Hispanic = 69.1 %; White = 53.5 %.
Intersectional reporting	Sex × Race/Ethnicity combinations with ≥ 2 % of the dataset and more than 10 candidates are available on request.
Statement of limitations	Small sample sizes preclude statistical-significance testing; demographic categories below 10 candidates or 2% were omitted; no disparate-impact conclusion is offered.
